# What is interventional radiology?

Interventional radiologists are board-certified physicians who specialize in minimally invasive, targeted treatments. They offer the most in-depth knowledge of the least invasive treatments available coupled with diagnostic and clinical experience across all specialties. They use x-rays, MRI, and other imaging to advance a catheter in the body, usually in an artery, to nonsurgically treat the source of the disease. As the inventors of angioplasty and the catheter-delivered stent, which were first used in the legs to treat peripheral arterial disease, interventional radiologists pioneered minimally invasive modern medicine.

Today, many conditions that once required surgery can be treated non-surgically by interventional radiologists. Interventional radiology treatments typically offer less risk, less pain, and less recovery time compared to open surgery.

## Procedures we offer

**Vascular:** angiogram, balloon angioplasty/stent, DVT, PVD treatment, venous insufficiency, IVC filter placement/retrieval, neurodiagnostics, embolization, adrenal vein sampling

**Hematology/Oncology:** chemoembolization, port placement, pheresis cath placements, Hickman placement, PICC line placement, radiofrequency ablations, TIPS, biliary intervention (PTC)

**Dialysis:** AV fistulagram/declot, vein mapping, temporary dialysis catheter placement

**Renal:** nephrostomy tube placement, ureteral stenting, renal artery angioplasty and stenting, renal RFA for tumor ablation

**Gynecology/Urology:** uterine fibroid embolization, varicocele embolization

**Orthopaedics:** kyphoplasty, vertebroplasty, bone/soft tissue tumor embolization
